

YOUTH VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

Thank you for your interest in the Summer Youth Program at Crozer-Keystone Health System. Being a volunteer is very special and requires thoughtful consideration of your commitment of time. Crozer-Keystone Health System offers many exciting opportunities in volunteer service.

Program requirements

The Summer Youth Volunteer Program begins the first week of July and ends the last week in August. Volunteers in the Youth Program must meet the following requirements:

- Must be at least 15 years to apply,
- Completed application, signed **education affiliation agreement** from his or her High School with CKHS.
- Written agenda with a developmental objective from student and high school.
- Signed parental consent form and Authorization and Release form.
- Completed medical forms,
- Confidential school counselor recommendation,
- Criminal background check, and Child Abuse Clearance (provided by CKHS).
- Immunization record for measles, mumps, rubella and chickenpox, flu, and TST testing.
- Results from a 2 step tuberculosis test completed within 6 months of volunteering,
- Volunteer Services interview completed before being accepted into the program. Must schedule an appointment.
- Attendance at Hospital orientation,
- Specific, hospital and departmental training,
- Uniform and dress standards,
- Punctuality and consistent attendance, accomplishing minimum service requirements
- 40 hours of service required for the summer youth program from July August

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All paperwork, testing, physician notes, etc must be completed and forwarded to Volunteer Services before May 15th, 2018. Failure to complete process by May 15th may result in non placement.

Benefits

The benefits of becoming a Crozer-Keystone Health System youth volunteer extends beyond your volunteer assignment. They are:

- Meal voucher following four hours of continuous service,
- Parking vouchers,
- Educational Experience

Goals of the Program

We hope to provide you with an experience that will be beneficial and introduce you to opportunities for available careers in the medical health care field. Crozer-Keystone Health System believes that our youth volunteers contribute many valuable services. Student **must have** an agenda with a development objective which will be enriching to them.

How to Apply

We would like the opportunity to discuss your interests, activities, previous volunteer experience, your preference for an assignment and availability.

After an assignment is agreed upon, you will be required to attend hospital orientation. This training/orientation is mandated by state law and hospital policy, and therefore the training topics of Infection Control, Patient Confidentiality/HIPAA, Fire/Safety, Age-Specific Competency, and Customer Satisfaction are required before volunteering in the hospital.
